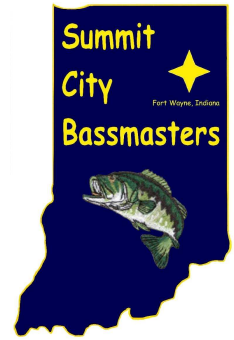

He handed out brochures for Mister Twister and discussed several new soft plastics, hooks and crankbait products and a trolling motor accessory called Shear Magic. Shear Magic cuts away weeds and fishing line before they have a chance to bog down your TM. It attaches with a band around your trolling motor with a blade on each side that extends over where the TM prop meets the TM.

April 23, 2005 is the SCBM Spring Open Tournament. The club decided that no club members would be allowed to fish this tournament.

Greg did make contact with Paul Hollabaugh and confirmed that we will have a TOP 8 tournament on Wawasee May 14th. and 15th. No other details at this time.
