If entering the Optional Pots it would be appreciated by Mr. Haines that payment be made Friday evening at the latest . Thanks.
There will be no off limits , so pre-fishing is acceptable anytime before the Tournament.

Payout Breakdown : This will be decided totaling the combined weight of the two days

1st = 40%
2nd = 20%
3rd = 17%
4th = 13%
5th = 10%

Big bass payout each day : this will be split if there are largemouth and smallmouth caught on the same day .

Club Points : Will be issued as per normal club rules for each day.

We are planning to stay at the Red Roof Inn at Roseville Michigan . Rate for a room with 2 beds is \$69.99 plus tax per night. The Phone # to the hotel is 1-586-296-0310 .

If you need a Canadian License you can call before Wednesday the 14th . Lakeside bait shop goes to Canada to pick up licenses on Wednesdays and they will have it waiting for you . Their number is 1-586-777-7003 , you will need a credit card to reserve your license. Or you can sweet talk your boater into taking you to the Canadian marina to pick one up . Non-resident Canadian licenses for 7 days are approximately \$50.00.

We will try to set up a place to have dinner together on Saturday night.

Guidelines for non-boater payment :

Towing vehical gas - depending on mileage.
Boat gas - depending on amount of time and distance traveled on water.
Launch fee - pay for one days launch , unless you are going up early with your boater , then split fees accordingly.
Hotel fees - If staying with your partner , half of room costs for nights you are there.
Make sure to bring your raingear & life vest !!

Boaters needed safety equipment for fishing Canadian waters :

50 ft. Floatable rope
Noise making device other than boat horn , i.e. whistle or air horn
Fire extinguisher
Life vest for every person in the boat
Waterproof flashlight >> check your batteries !!
Bailing bucket
Anchor w/50 ft. of rope
Emergency oar

If you plan to fish Canadian waters you must have a Canadian License !!!!

If you plan to fish the Walpole Indian Reservation you must have a Reservation License !!! These waters might be closed for duck season .
