Minutes of March meeting from newsletter Accepted on a motion by Rob Stroupe

There was discussion about the Insurance coverage for the club concerning sponsored events . It is our understanding that the club is covered with insurance. Since our rooster and dues were sent and paid to the TBF and IBF.

There was an Ice Breaker tournament report of activities from Greg Rekeweg. 19 entries are paid so far. And it was asked that all club members without previous plans to attend to help out with the running of this Club Sponsored event. There will be a full update to the ICEBREAKER in the May newsletter.

A Committee was organized to go through the SCBM Constitution and By-Laws . This committee will be in charge of updating these documents for club approval. Bill Hovermale , Dan White , Greg Rekeweg , Wendel Brown , and Paul Cavanaugh volunteered .

Rob Stroupe submitted a motion to the floor to add to the By-Laws Article 4 , section B , sub-section 23 . Proposed addition to read that Show points will not be lost from members total points for end of
