New Business:

1. Meeting Date Change. Wendel Brown introduced a discussion that the July Meeting should be rescheduled. The meeting is currently set for the first Tuesday of the month, which happens to be Independence Day, July 4th. It was discussed if the meeting should be moved one day to the 5th or one week to the 11th. It was decided that the 5th would be a better choice on the grounds that meeting room at Gander Mountain is booked on the 11th. A second point made was that if we moved the meeting to the 11th there would not be another meeting before the

Hamilton Tournament and we would need to sign up for the Hamilton pairings tonight. A motion was made to reschedule the July 4th meeting to Wednesday July 5th 2006. Motion was passed, with no one opposed.

2. Discussion from Top-8. Overall the club finished in 5th place and Greg presented a check for \$110.00 back to the club.
3. Kid's Outing. Max Egley gave an update on the Kid's Outing. The date of August 12th, 2006 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm has been chosen for the outing. The times for club members are from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Doug reports that we have tackle boxes but are in need of poles. Max is going to contact the Zebco representative and see what he (Zebco) can do to help.
4. Vote on Change to the By-Lays. During the May meeting Wendel Brown had submitted a priliminary Constitution and Bylaws change. These changes were to be voted on in the June meeting. No vote was made because the constitution states that a letter needs to be sent out to all members one week prior to any vote on the constitution and by-laws. This vote will be postponed to the July meeting so proper notice can be given.
5. Club Secretary. Wendel Brown introduced a letter to the meeting attendees from Rob Stroup. At this time Rob is stepping down as Club Secretary. Rob stated that his work schedule has been such that he can no longer plan on leaving work it be at the meetings. He does plan on continuing as a member and fishing tournaments with us.

Wendel asked if there would be any volunteers to take over as Club Secretary. It was decided that there were several possible candidates that were not in attendance. Until they can be contacted, Jim Graham will take over the newsletters. Kyle Winling took the minutes of the July meeting.

6. Wawasee Tournament. A discussion was brought up that the Club's tournament on Wawasee is scheduled for the same date as the Top-8 Tournament on Lake Monroe, July 30th, 2006. The tournament committee is to find a date and an open location to hold the tournament that month so as not to interfere with the Top-8.

Old Business:

1. Tournament Pairings Discussion. Reminder – It is the non-boaters responsibility to contact the boater prior to a tournament to make plans on where to meet etc. If a non-boater cannot make a tournament, they are to contact not only the boater they are paired with but also the tournament director, Bill Hovermale. It should be

assumed that if you have not spoken to both of these people in person, (i.e. left a message or email, and not heard back) that you have not gotten the message though. Call again or call someone else.

This discussion came up as a result of 3 boaters being by themselves at the Clear Lake tournament.
