New Business:

1. Top Eight. The top eight competitors will be as follows. Boaters: Greg Rekeweg, Bob Bruick, Bill Hovermale, Max Egley, Non-Boaters: Mark Kirk, Jim Graham, Nate Fox, Phil Scribner. The Top 8 tournament is this coming weekend June 8th and 9th 2007 on Wawasee. Competitors are to meet at More Boats Friday. Registration begins at 5:00 PM and the meeting begins at 6:00 PM. You are to bring your FLW card to the meeting and it was the consensus of the past competitors that boaters should bring their insurance papers with them to the meeting.
2. Turnstone Outing. The outing this year has been scheduled for July 21st. The rain date is the 28th of July. The hours are 8:00 to 2:00 for club members and 9:00 to 1:00 for our guests. The location will be at the Concordia Seminary. Gary Sanderlin has arranged the use of the pond and access for our guests should be a little easier.

The hours this year have been moved up at the recommendation of the Turnstone director. We will fish until lunch and rap things up at that point.

Doug Haines stated that we have about 20 fishing rods and maybe as many as 40 tackle boxes. Doug is going to check and report by the next meeting.

At the July meeting we will put together final plans. In the mean time Bob Bruick will work on finding a Porta John.

3. Classic. Max Egley stated that he was planning this year's classic at Patoka Reservoir. Max is asking that the tournament be moved to October 20th and 21st. This would make the classic two weeks after the coldwater tournament. The reason for the switch would be that the fishing on Patoka would be better in October then September.

Max stated that he is looking into lodging at either French Lick or Jasper. Several other ideas were brought up and Max will look into them as well.

Wendel suggested that the Classic and Coldwater dates be swapped.

There will be a discussion at the July meeting of moving the tournament and a possible vote. If you have questions, comments or concerns, come to the July meeting.

4. Money Tournament. In addition to moving the classic to October. Max introduced an idea that a Money tournament be inserted in September on the date previously held by the classic. Max said he would like to see a two day outing to St. Clair that would pay a couple of places. This would not be a points tournament.

5. Website. Wendel Brown announced changes to the website and the addition of a members only area. Wendel has been working on an area that we can compile fishing information and access it at a later date. Currently the area only accepts information as a trial, and he is asking that you make comments on additions or changes that you would like to see. Check it out and let Wendel know what you think.

Information would be accessible to all club members through a user name and password. If you do not have your password and user name, contact Wendel Brown for details.

Jim Graham has added a picture area to the website. Jim would like you to email him any pictures that you would like to have added. Let him know what tournament the pictures are from and they will be added to that tournaments picture file. If you have a great fishing shot that was not at a general tournament submit them as well and they will be added to the bottom of that years picture page.

6. New Member. Aaron Krider submitted an application for admission into the club. Many of you may remember Arron from the snow drift in/on his boat prior to the Webster tournament this year. Aaron was voted and we welcome him.
7. Club Image. Wendel made a comment that although not specifically against the clubs By-Laws since the tournament is over, he feels that on lookers may be getting the wrong impression when we partake of alcoholic beverages. He is asking that club members wait until they have left the tournament site to consume adult beverages.
8. Meeting Program: Mike Uptgraft presented the club with a short program on buoys and signage pertaining to the upcoming trip to Lake Erie Tournament. Mike stated that he would Email a link to the club members for future reference. Nice Job Mike, thanks.
