## **New Business:**

1. **Membership** – No new business.
2. **Classic Report** - Max Egley has stepped down as classic director and Kevin Galbreath has stepped in to take over. Kevin reports at this point we have cancelled the second cabin. If the owners can rent it for the weekend, the deposit on the cabin will be added to the first cabin. If they cannot rent the second cabin the cost will be divided back into the cost of the first cabin. This will add about \$5.00 per night per man. The cabin we have as bedding for 8. It has been suggested that if you have a sleeping bag or air mattress to bring it. You should also bring your own towel and wash cloth. If you forget either of these items, there will be the initials of BB (Bob Bruick) on the wash cloth and towel you should use. You will however, need to borrow someone else's shampoo...

Kevin has asked that you bring cash to pay for the tournament big bass and cabin. If you are staying Friday and Saturday nights plan on at least \$80.00 and \$105.00 for all three nights.

3. Kevin is planning on paying out four places each day. Approximately payouts are

  - 3) \$100.00
  - 4) \$75.00
4. Tournament hours are Saturday 8:00 to 4:00 and Sunday 8:00 to 2:00. Not the Sunday time may be changed based on feed back from the group.

5. **Ice Breaker** – Bill Alday and Bob Bruick will be heading up the Ice Breaker in 2008. Bob was overcome by Bills excitement and has agreed to help out again this year. There was a discussion regarding changing the date of the Ice Breaker to avoid conflict with the federation held the same month. Bob Bruick will attempt to contact Doug Bradley to see if we can plan around the Federation Tournament. At this point We have set a date of April 19<sup>th</sup>. If the Federation Tournament is the Same Weekend, The Ice Breaker may be moved.
6. **Banquet** – Phil Scribner has been in contact with Chops Steak House. The only Saturday that they have open following our last tournament is November 10<sup>th</sup>. Phil has reserved this date. Tentative time is 7:00 pm.
7. **Appetizers** – A motion was made that the club play for 3 plates of appetizers for the banquet at an approximate cost of \$150.00. The motion past with none opposed.
8. **Banquet Plaques** – Mark Kirk is going to contact the plaque maker. He will check to see if he would like a partial order now for the tournaments we have completed and a final order when we finish the Chapman Lake Tournament or wants to wait and do it all at once.
