Old Business:

1. **Turnstone** – Mark Kirk reported that the VA has backed out of the event that Turnstone was hosting for the disabled veterans. He mentioned that they also did not have any veterans signed up. There was a discussion around resending last month's proposal to donate up to \$500 for this event since there were not going to be any veterans involved.

New Business:
